
# Enhanced Publications ('Verrijkte Publicatie')



Enhanced Publication definition of DRIVER II:

*An enhanced publication is a publication that is enriched with three categories of information:*

- research data (evidence of the research)*
- extra materials (to illustrate or clarify)*
- post-publication data (commentaries, ranking)*

### Verrijkte Publicatie

Onderzoeken en docenten hebben dankzij de mogelijkheden die het internet biedt, gemakkelijk en brede toegang tot wetenschappelijke bronnen. Naar publicaties kunnen bestrekken, maar bijvoorbeeld ook de onderliggende dataverzamelingen, modellen en algoritmen. Door het toevoegen van de achterliggende onderzoeksdata en modellen bij een publicatie, wordt het gemakkelijker om de resultaten te verifiëren, reproduceren en te hergebruiken.

**Wat is een Verrijkte Publicatie?**  
Een verrijkte publicatie maakt uit een artikel, metingen, foto's, video's en extra materialen, een publicatie van een artikel in een tijdschrift, een proefschrift, rapport, notitie of een hoofdstuk. Er kan een artikel zijn dat een enkele of meerdere verschillende onderzoeken of (wetenschappelijk) onderslagen past en een interpretatie of analyse bevat van inhoudelijke data of en logische modellen. De verrijkte publicatie van bijvoorbeeld bestaat uit onderzoeksdata, modellen, algoritmen, bestudinale illustratie, methodenbeschrijvingen, data sets, commentaren en ranking gegevens. Door deze veranderingen post-publicatie data is het mogelijk dat een verrijkte publicatie blijft korreleren met andere verrijkte publicaties.

**Samenwerking aan infrastructuur**  
SURF werkt samen met de Universiteiten, Data & Knowledge Services Services (DANS), de Koninklijke Bibliotheek, het STU-databasecentrum en andere relevante organisaties en instellingen aan de ontwikkeling van de infrastructuur voor verrijkte publicaties. Internationaal wordt veel samengewerkt met partners in Knowledge Exchange (ZINC uit de UK), de BPG uit China en de Chinese National Library and Information Service in het DRIVER II project dat is gefinancierd uit het zevende Vaderprogramma van de Europese Commissie (FP7).


