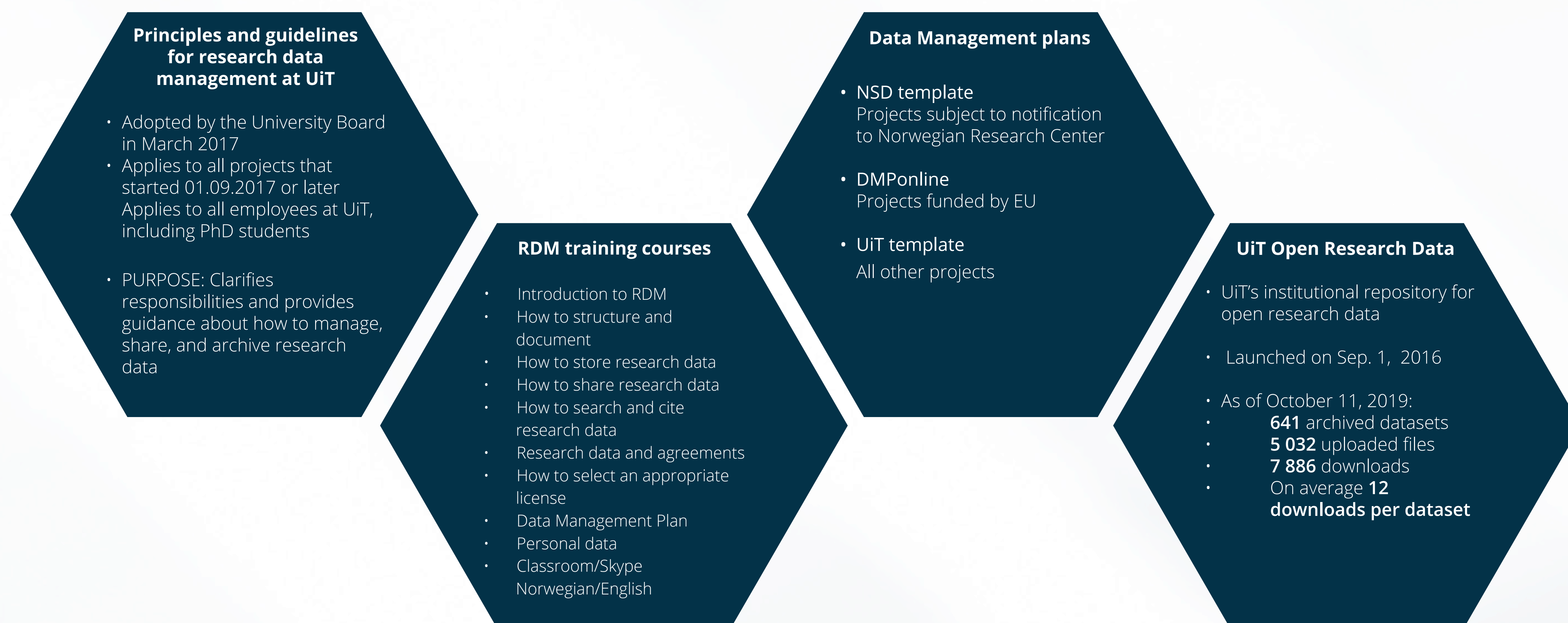

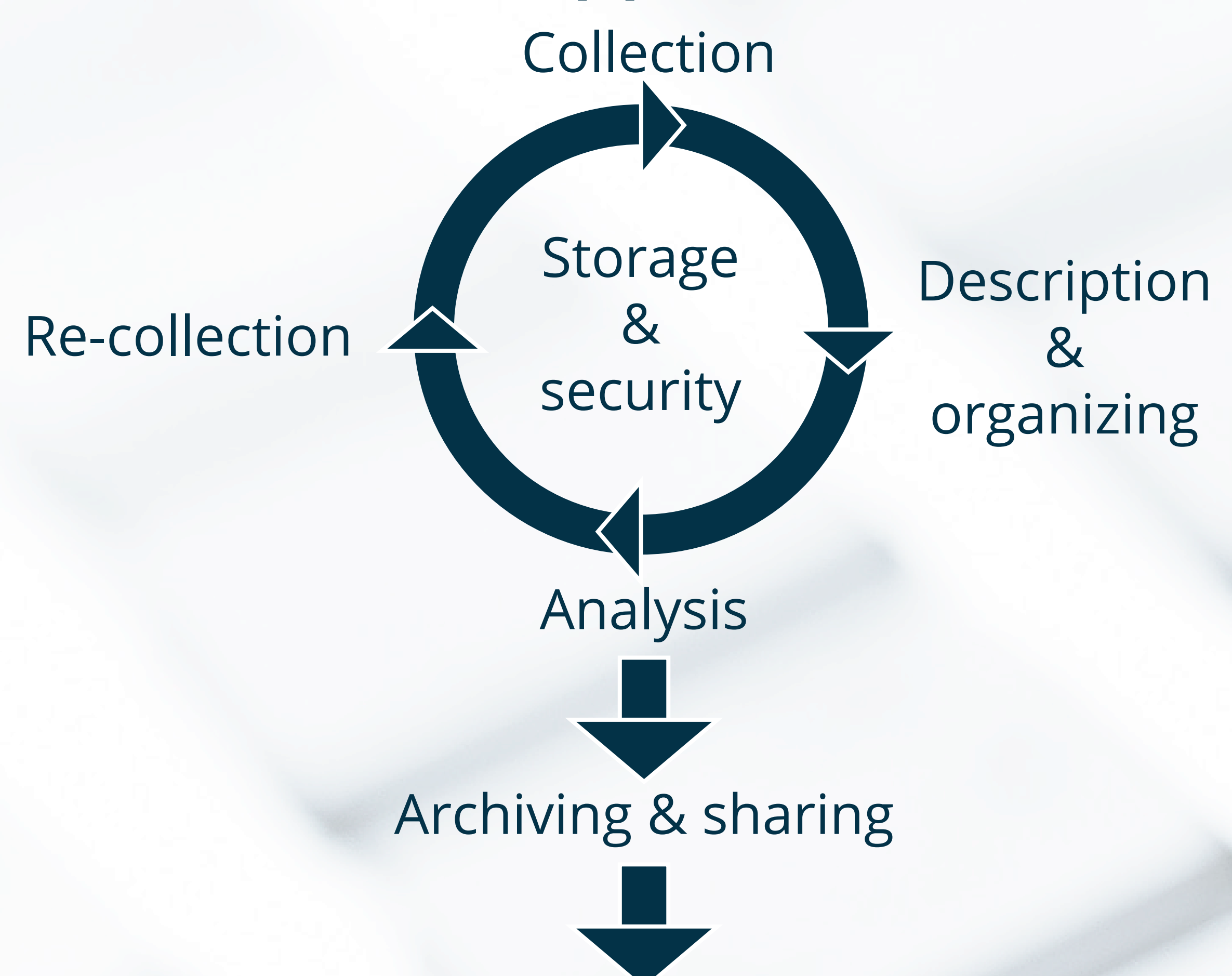

Data curation support services at UiT



Curation adds value & increases the quality of data



Check compliance with deposit guidelines

- Adequate metadata
- ReadMe file
- Preferred file formats
- Choice of license
- Request enhancements



System features

- Persistent identifier (DOI)
- Clear user license
- Open & standard metadata
- Searchable & indexed
- Open protocols
- Adequate authentication

Senior Research Data Project

3 years project, started in 2017

Aim: preserve research data from UiT's senior researchers



Professor Robert T. Barrett at Tromsø University Museum

Has collected data about seabirds and migratory birds for over 40 years

Retired June 2018

All of his data (close to 25 datasets) are archived at UiT Open Research Data archive and available to all
