## What is accessibility?

### **Open Access**

- Free, immediate, unrestricted, online availability of research
- Promise that **anyone can use** results
- More equitable knowledge ecosystem

### Accessibility

Ensures digital content is barrier free through design standards

- Universal formats
- Easy to perceive
- Easy to operate
- Easy to understand

### Innovation

- Workflows for **born-accessible** scholarly communications
- Accessible practices for authors, editors, publishers, and all actors in this ecosystem
- Format convergence in **EPUB 3+** 
  - DAISY book formats for readers with print disabilities
  - W3C digital accessibility for the web, across all disabilities and tech
