

erih+ is open to all journals, but with a special focus on community-driven and scholar-led journals.



Why support community-driven journals?

- Commercially published journals are supported by their publisher.
- Most recognized indexes do not specialize in supporting scholar-led journals.
- Clearer guidelines can help journals take the next step.
- Incentivizing the inclusion of information: Updated metadata-schema.
- Supporting the community = Supporting the publishing landscape.

- Making erih+ a recognized source for National evaluations in different European countries.





In 2023 erih+ became a member of the Research Infrastructure OPERAS:


The Arctic University of Tromsø is also a member, and together we form the start of OPERAS Norway. We are very active participants in the RI:
