- presentation (oral, poster)

The grants are to be used in the financial year of 1996. Successful applicants must report to NOR before receiving the grant. Student applicants are prioritized and, this year, the main purpose for the NOR grant is to support participation at the 1996 NOR-workshop in Uppsala (Ninth Nordic Workshop on Reindeer Research).


