The second announcement is now dispathed together with a call for papers and a Registration form and a form for Abstracts.

As previously mentioned we will try to give this symposium a poster profile. There are at least two good reasons for this, (i) a poster, professionally designed, presents an excellent source of information on the essentials of a paper, (ii) at an informal hearing in Whitehorse back in 1985 everybody present agreed that poster presentation should be recommended. Moreover, the opportunity will be provided for posters of general interest to be briefly presented *ex cathedra* followed by a public discussion. It should also be stated that the paper on which a poster is based will of course be referred and published in the proceedings as will papers orally presented. More detailed instructions will follow in due time.

In order to emphasize our interest in posters we intend to appoint an *ad hoc* jury, the tasks of which would be to select the three best posters as far as design, content, readability etcetera are concerned. In addition to the great honour of beeing selected there will be prizes of some kind.
